1. Review/approve of minutes from November 14, 2018 meeting
November minutes were reviewed. Dave motioned to approve the minutes, with a second from Patty. All approved, with John abstaining.
2. Public comment
No members of the public were present.
3. Community Updates
 - a. Hopland Band of Pomo Indians – 101/175 intersection
The HMAc was unable to make contact with the Hopland Band of Pomo Indians regarding an update to the coffee cart project that was originally presented to the HMAc at the August 16, 2017 meeting and followed-up with a presentation at the September 19, 2018 meeting. This item will remain on the agenda.
 - b. NCRA Lease for railroad property
This item has been continued from previous meetings. Julie shared that she heard that the lease of the pear packing shed near the corner of Highways 101 and 175 has not been renewed. The HMAc has not recently heard from the individuals responsible for the NCRA property leases but will continue to follow up and keep this item on the agenda, until such time as it is no longer relevant.
 - c. MTA Bus Schedule to Hopland
Julie shared that she visited and emailed two individuals at the MTA regarding the possibility of extending MTA service to Hopland. She has asked about the possibility of additional stops in Hopland in the evenings on Fridays and Saturdays and in the afternoon on Sundays. Dave suggested that if she is able to get ahold of the MTA, she propose the idea of monthly routes at the additional times.

c. Hopland School Committee

At the last meeting, Amy shared that she would be meeting with the Ukiah Unified School District Superintendent, Deb Kubin, on Friday, November 16th. Amy was not in attendance at the HMAC meeting to share an update. This item will be revisited during the January meeting.

Review of the provided list and discussion of this item will be revisited during the January meeting when more members of the HMAC are present.

b. Next Steps

For the upcoming year, Dave would like to focus on communicating more directly with Senator McGuire's office, in part to ensure that the aforementioned transportation/safety meeting takes place. In 2019, the HMAC would also like to make an effort to reach out to additional members of the community and encourage their attendance at future meetings, including newly elected Supervisor District 5, Ted Williams.
